Deadline reminders: HEDIS[®] MY 2024 supplemental data

Providers who have begun supplemental data feed implementation for MY 2024 are required to provide approved, clean test files by **August 26** to ensure smooth processing of MY 2024 HEDIS data. If the data does not pass the supplemental data clinical audit on the first round, the deadline to submit corrected files is October 11.

Supplemental data feeds benefit providers by capturing relevant HEDIS data, such as test results not obtained via claims or services rendered before the member's enrollment with Meridian, to support more accurate care gap reports, better real-time interventions, and potential increased pay for performance earnings. <u>Contact Elizabeth James</u> if you are interested in a supplemental data feed for MY 2025.

Fee schedule updates, rate changes, & billing updates

Claim alerts and known issues are posted on our <u>website</u>, along with updates from Meridian about proactively reprocessing claims. Claims should not be resubmitted unless otherwise indicated. If you have questions about billing, contact your assigned Provider Engagement Administrator or representative. If your practice doesn't have an assigned representative, please complete our <u>intake form</u>.

- The Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) issued a <u>provider notice</u> informing Specialized Mental Health Rehabilitation Facilities of rate changes effective **July 1, 2024**.
- <u>HFS informed nursing facilities</u> of a support rate component increase and increased add-on rate for ventilator services effective **January 1, 2024**.

In case you missed it

- **Effective July 1, 2024**, an additional review went into effect for <u>place of service</u> (POS) ambulance claims to ensure claims have the appropriate POS code.
- HFS added a new Enhanced Ambulatory Patient Grouping (EAPG) to its list of EAPGs that qualify for the High-Cost Device Add-On Payment and will be

adjusting previously paid claims impacted by <u>this update</u>. A revised EAPG calculator has been posted to HFS's <u>Pricing Calculators</u> page.

 Home and community-based service providers should know the implementation of the Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) program for personal care services under the Aging waiver <u>will not go live on November 1 as previously scheduled</u>.
 Providers will be notified once a new date is scheduled.
